# The ISEKI\_Food-4 project the 4<sup>th</sup> cycle of the successful ISEKI\_Food projects

The ISEKI\_Food-4 project (project number 518415-LLP-1-2011-1-IT-ERASMUS-ENW, acronym IFOOD4) has started officially its activities on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2011, coordinated by Paola Pittia of the Faculty of Agriculture of the University of Teramo (Italy). This project, as the previous ones, is funded by the Executive Agency, Education, Culture, Audiovisual, under the Lifelong Learning Programme, Erasmus Thematic Networks (action C). The subtitle of the project is "Towards the innovation of the food chain through the modernisation of Food studies"

This project includes 86 partners from 27 EU countries and 3 partners from no-EU countries (Brasil, US and Israel); 31 associated partners from 15 EU and no-EU countries have been also included in the list of the project participants.

Main aims of the project are the development of a framework of stakeholders to lead innovation in Food studies education & training fitting enterprises'



needs, promoting innovation in the FS&T academic sector, and supporting the EU Food studies internationalization by:

- the modernisation of the education, training and curricula development;
- the implementation of the labour market role in the 3<sup>rd</sup> level of education and promotion of the employability & entrepreneurship of the FS&T graduates and food professionals;
- lecturing qualification, in particular of the Food Science and Technology teaching staff.

By the activities planned in the 3-years duration of the project several deliverables are expected to be achieved and in particular: a toolbox on the Virtual Network Environment for materials and tools to implement and Food modernise Studies programmes and to promote their internationalisation; a qualification frame for Higher Education Teaching Staff; a Virtual Platform for doctoral candidates to favour their networking and training with material useful to acquire knowledge and technology transfer skills; innovative teaching materials (books; e-learning training courses; a pilot "Virtual lab"; a database of research project networks.

The editing of the issues of the new-born ISEKI\_Food e-journal (<a href="http://www.iseki-food-ejournal.com/">http://www.iseki-food-ejournal.com/</a>), the 3<sup>rd</sup> ISEKI\_Food conference (2014), webinars, the pilot test of a Summer School for teachers, and a document on the ethical and social role of the Food studies and food professional are also planned among the exploitation activities of the project.

#### **Project planning and Work Packages**

The IFOOD4 project activities are organised in 8 Work Packages and 4 out of them (WP3, WP4, WP5 and WP6) are running the activities to implement the project planning; the others are supporting the previous ones by taking care the exploitation of the implemented activities (WP6), the dissemination of the project and its activities (WP2) and the quality plans (WP1) and management (WP8). In Table 1, the list of the Work Packages and the Core Group members are briefly summarised.

#### How the project will be working

All partners know that the budget of the Erasmus Thematic Network projects could only support a limited number of activities and the organisation of the meetings of the partners.

The high number of partners and the budget available for IFOOD4 will allow (1) to develop a series of electronic, web-based tools that will be hosted in the project website and/or within the ISEKI\_Food Association website, and that will be available for all the partners; (2) to organise a series of meetings where partners will discuss and run activities required for the achievement of the project outputs.

Partners and associated partners will be invited by email, sent by the project coordinator and/or the WP coordinators, with the invitation to collaborate to the specific activities; an interactive website of the project is under development aimed to favour the communication among the partners and





between partners and the project coordinator and the dissemination of the project outputs.

Associated partners will be invited to contribute to all the project activities, included the project meetings that they could attend without financial support by the IFOOD4 project.

The contribution of all the partners is thus of vital importance for the achievement of all the challenging results of the IFOOD4 project.

To favour the development of the activities, the involvement of colleagues and institution partners is needed as well as of other stakeholder representatives (students, industry associations, etc.) in each country, and I kindly invite all IFOOD4 partners and associated to plan collaborations in this respect.

#### **Example for using the ISEKI-e-learning platform**

Under the ISEKI\_Food and ISEKI\_Mundus projects, an e-learning platform (<a href="https://www.iseki-food.net/E-learning">https://www.iseki-food.net/E-learning</a>) with several e-learning courses for undergraduate, graduate students and industrial people was developed. Every course can be used by members of the ISEKI\_Food Association (IFA) for free, 50 € will be charged for non-members to use a course for a period of 6 months. Members of the ISEKI-Food Association (IFA) have also the possibility to use these courses as teacher to interact with their students and/or to create their own courses in this platform. Gerhard Schleining used the latter opportunity very efficiently, when he was teaching a course on Computer Applications in Food Processing and Quality Assurance as a guest at the Kasetsart University in Bangkok. It took him about one week to prepare



the course and to provide and update existing powerpoint slides and other electronic material for the participants. Interactivity was achieved by assigning tasks to individuals and groups and to use discussion forums, where the participants had to ask a questions regarding a topic and to answer a questions from the others. Forums were also used to allow the participants to post information which was not mentioned during the lecture in order to collect and share new knowledge. Each single task and contribution can be assessed and the system calculates automatically the results for each participant which can be used as part of the final grade. Several features allow also to carry out the final exam online. The system is so easy to use, that an introduction of about 10 minutes was sufficient for the pasticipants. Further Gerhard Schleining sees also a big advantage in the fact that the developed course material can be used, modified and enriched by other teachers very easily.

#### **OMAN** - Conference

IFA was invited to take part at the **2nd Oman Food Safety Conference** from 10/10/ to 11/10/2011 in Muscat, Sultanate of OMAN. It was for the first time that IFA was represented at an event in the Middle East Region.

The OMAN is located at the Eastern part of the Arabian Peninsula, with the capital Muscat. The sultanate has appr. 2,8 Mill. Inhabitants, mainly living in the cities, more than 25 % of the population are foreign workers. 75 % of the population has Islamic religion. The Sultanate is absolute monarchy but has at the same time a constitution. Since 41 years the country is guided by Sultan Qabus.

The conference was organized by OITE (a conference organizer) and was supported by Ministry of Commerce & Industry and the Ministry of Regional Municipalities &Water Resources. The conference took place in one of the most exciting hotel and conference venue in the region, the Al Bustan Palace Hotel, in a suburb of Muscat. More than 250 participants were invited to take part in the conference, mainly from Oman, Saudi Arabia, UAE (United Arab Emirate) and only a few participants from other parts of the world (USA, UK, Australia and Austria).

IFA had the privilege to be involved in the Opening Session with a plenary paper. Helmut GLATTES presented a paper with the title:

# ISEKI-Food Association (IFA) its Aims and Initiatives with special emphasis to the Middle East,

The paper was prepared with support of Cristina Silva and Gerhard Schleining. We have included into the paper examples of possible common activities for the "Middle East", like


- create content for e-learning courses, books, specific to needs of the region
- translate existing IFA-materials (books, courses) into Arabic language and distribute it
- organise "IFA-workshops" for the local industry, PhD-Seminars etc.
- increase quality of Food Study Programmes (tuning, accreditation by EQAS)

There was a great interest in the IFA-presentation and the majority of the participants have heard for the first time about ISEKI in general and in particular about IFA. It was also possible to distribute IFA- materials and to discuss with the participants many IFA-related subjects.

Especially contacts were established to colleagues from USA, Australia and UAE.



The event was excellently organized, the hospitality was great and the open minded people from the OMAN contributed to the good atmosphere and success of the conference.


He always wanted to ensure the quality of student education by improving the teaching of food science and technology.
